Eidsvold Annual Meeting Summary held January 22, 2023

Meeting called to order by Justin Mandelkow at 12 PM. Review of 2022 meeting notes, approved as read.

Pastor's Report and Pastoral Acts 2022 were in the annual report.

Financial reports accepted as presented Treasurer Anne Girdeen noted the parsonage committee balance should be 16,822.35.

Missions for 2023 approved as follows:

Northwest Synod to remain at 11% of offerings; Lutheran Social Services (LSS) will remain at \$650.

Kathy Sears requested the \$2000 be given to Ellsworth Food Pantry instead of Pierce County Hunger Prevention Fund to keep assistance more local. Approved Eidsvold Cemetery fund request of \$500.

Sunday School amount will remain at \$250; HOPE Coalition will return to \$200

The following missions will remain at last year's giving: ARC Inc. \$1350, Luther Point \$500; Ellsworth Senior Center \$500; Bay City Senior Center \$200.

Eidsvold Women will try to host an ice cream social in early fall of 2023.

Dennis Finstad provided an explanation of the endowment fund.

Melody appealed to upgrade subscriptions to music libraries so it is easier to collect and share lyrics and music in weekly services. This will save a lot of time and headaches for Melody, Tracie and Tana. Motion to pay up to \$500 for this upgrade, approved and passed.

New business:

Discussion on moving forwad wit joint ministry with Svea. EIDSVOLD LUTHERAN CHURCH:

STRENGTHS: Sunday School, Children messages, our building, financially strong, members who get along and like each other, many younger families attending, no political division, Eidsvold has been a church home for many generations for some of the current members, a welcoming congregation, nice parking lot, Worship in the Park, elevator, projection screen; Facebook and website.

WEAKNESSES OR WHAT WE COULD DO BETTER: nothing for youth 6th grade and older - have tried to offer events but youth don't come (suggestion: involve these confirmation age students by having them help with Sunday School, usher, light candles, ring the bell, serve the church in some way); have worship available online; follow-up with visitors so they feel welcomed; seems to be the same volunteers for cleaning, ushering, bringing food for events

Our society has gymnastics, basketball, hockey, softball-baseball, skiing – athletic events on Sunday mornings so participants and families are not able to attend Sunday worship;

HOPES FOR FUTURE: continue to have worship in this building weekly

CONCERNS as discussions continue with Eidsvold, Bethlehem, and Svea:

don't want to lose what we already have; want strong leadership in our pastor, pastor who lives in the area; don't want to merge congregations but continue as individual congregations served by one pastor, if discussion continue as a 2 point parish, will the expense for pastor, housing, insurance, benefits be attainable?

If you have thoughts, comments, or concerns to add to this list, please let Jason Helseth 612-598-2808 or Tracie Esterby 651-380-2212 know so they can be included.

Reminder: No decisions will be made regarding future ministry without every member's voice - a congregational meeting must be called to make any decisions and vote on the matter.

It is Eidsvold's hope, that all 25 of these participants plus an additional 25 come Thursday evening, February 2nd to Svea at 7:00 p.m. to listen and share opinions and thoughts in the discussion about future ministry. All members are invited to participate in these discussions.
