






r. This calendar will provide inspirational ideas for daily reflection and action as well as prayers, relevant Bible passages, and more to guide us on our 40 days of Giving Journey for World Hunger.

You are invited to **Pray, Fast, Reflect,** and **Give** during the ELCA World Hunger's 40 Days of Giving – for families, our neighbors and communities around the world.

As the world has reeled from the effects of a deadly pandemic for nearly three years, we have

seen the number of hungry people around the world rise, watched as food pantries and soup kitchens expanded to serve an evergrowing number of guests, and longed together for the time when



we "will hunger no more, and thirst no more ... and God will wipe away every tear from [our] eyes" (Revelation 7:16-17). This yearning is at the heart of who we are as church together. We are an Easter people, ever journeying toward the cross and ever mindful of helping our neighbors.

Eidsvold Council Meeting Summary Wednesday, February 23, 2022

Sanctuary painting is complete—new glass for lights to be installed by end of week and then scaffolding can be removed. Front entrance should be done this week; kitchen and bathrooms, upstairs room yet to be painted.

Motion seconded and carried to remove one row of pews from each side to increase space between pews.

Set Sunday, Feb 27th at 5PM to start reinstalling pews, contingent upon scaffolding removed.

Well pump at church has been running a lot. Hoyer checked it and options are to wait until it goes or replace it. Motion made and seconded to get a quote for replacing.

Anniversary notes:

- Need to kick off fundraising efforts (bake sale, generational/memorium/in honor of donations/ engraved brick pavers to be used in landscaping)
- Plan programming (letters were mailed this week to all former pastors informing of date)
- Landscape after exterior has been painted

IF YOU BUILD IT, THEY WILL COME!

Around 50 years ago, a hay field was converted to a softball field that is still used today and is known as the Our Savior's Lutheran Ball field. Many church teams have played ball here throughout the years (including Bethlehem-Eidsvold ball teams).

They currently have 8 teams for this coming season and want at least 2 more teams. Donna Constant says, "It is rewarding to hear players come up and tell us what being involved has done for them and how it has changed them to become better people." Improvements made throughout the years include bleachers, scoreboard, safety nets, new lights and light poles, playground equipment and more.

Now they want to make it better. The next project is to add a real bathroom with running water. It will double as a storm shelter. This means drilling a well, installation of a septic system, and erecting a building to reach this goal. Running water will also be a big asset to the concession stand. The park is used by people on bikes and motorcycles, runners, family gatherings, and more. This addition will benefit the community and make the park a better place for everyone.
