Phyllis will continue to be the musician at Bethlehem, where she is a member.

It is fine if you want to include a gift with your card. I have been on the receiving end of a card shower and it is a great experience to sit down and go through the cards one by one.

Etta Mork's retirement was recognized in January of 1987 but she had stopped as organist in the fall of 1986. Linda Rieck played at St. John's and Eidsvold according to the 1986. and 1987 bulletins and in the May 1988 council minutes, the organist was asking for the summer off. I played occasionally at Eidsvold since the early 1970's as a substitute and for evening services - Lenten services, Thanksgiving Eve, and for the 10:30 or 11 p.m. Christmas Eve Candlelight Services. Do you remember those services? I've been playing for worship since age 15 and its part of who I am. Thank you for the opportunity.

Present for the meeting: Pastor Mike, Justin M., Jason H., Laura P., Anne G.

Treasurer's Report was read and approved . Building/Anniversary balance \$11,889.86

New business: 1 - FM transmitter is not working. Motion, seconded to troubleshoot to see if it will work, if not discontinue for summer and re-address purchase of new one as need arises.

2- with covid on the rise, will continue with prepackaged communion cups; will revisit based on supply and health conditions, and informal poll of congregation

- 3 need to find one or two people to put offerings in the safe after worship
- 4 reviewed Sundays pastor has scheduled off for summer and early fall
- 5 summer worship, joint and park, need to be scheduled
- 6 Discussed getting the church sign fixed.

7 - Painting is completed. Steeple had rotting wood; painter was able to repair but added to the cost; discussed replacing main door and windows from the parking lot; will look into options and quotes

8 - Melody is interested in being the primary pianist and has others for rotation and fill in. Will have recognition for Phyllis on June 5th.

9 - Pastor has scheduled meeting for June 23rd with Synod Pastor Erin Nelson and Lutheran churches in the area, inviting pastor, council members and key leaders to discuss ways we might work together, especially with youth ministry and outreach. Thursday, June 23 at 6 p.m. at Our Savior's Lutheran.

10 - Pastor discussed Top of Steeple Renovation to recreate what the steeple looked like when church was dedicated in 1906. Will need to find a lift tall enough to reach the top; has checked into lightning strikes in the county and with insurance and was reassured the church would be covered.
