Greetings from the Parsonage,

November is a busy month in the Church. We start with All Saints Sunday and end with the First Sunday of Advent, with Christ the King Sunday in between. It is easy to lose track of all of these holidays—ones not even banks recognize—but they have a purpose. The Church Calendar—seasons, feasts, and all—teaches us how to see the world through a Christian lens.

In some ways, the Liturgical Year (the \$10 term for the Church Calendar—sure to impress others) is like a workout regimen through which the Holy Spirit strengthens us. Some holidays may seem strange, perhaps not what we would choose, but they offer something to our lives—they build the muscles we may have not yet needed. Here are two that will greet us in November.

All Saints Sunday (Nov. 2) is the day we mourn as a congregation. In an age with more "Celebrations of Life" or no service at all, All Saints ensures Jesus enters our grief and guides us onward to hope. Although we read the all names from the parish of those who went before us this year, we sometimes do not share our individual losses with others. This is why we invite anyone who wishes to light a candle in silence to do so. I light one every year for my father. In Christ, all the faithful are made saints and are worthy to be remembered. On this day, we do not pray to these saints, but rather join their prayers in Heaven.

Christ the King Sunday (Nov. 23) is a reminder that although we have differing political opinions—which is a sign of a healthy community—Jesus remains the King of our lives. It is a holiday celebrated across the world: under authoritarian regimes, constitutional monarchies, and democratic republics. It is the Church's protest against those who attempt to silence Christ's rule, and it remind us all of the King we will one day answer to. On this Sunday, the student-pastor at United Lutheran will be sharing the message.

Something to look forward to...

On Wednesday, December 3, we will have our **First Annual Parish Chili Cookoff**. This year, the cookoff will be at Eidsvold—next year it will be at Svea. Together, our parish can do some marvelous things—both in service and in fellowship. However, if that is not enough of a motivator, Pastor Al has a "Golden Crockpot" trophy for the winner. The winning cook will get their name written on the back, and their parish will have the honor of displaying the "Golden Crockpot" until next year. Following the cookoff, we will have our first of three Advent services. Like Lent, these will rotate between the churches. The Chili Cookoff is not in the Liturgical Year, but it will surely be a delicious blessing.
