A Note from Pastor Al:

The Pierce County Fair quickly approaches! As many of you know, this year, our Parish has been given a booth in the round barn. This is a wonderful outreach opportunity as the Fair attracts thousands of visitors from our area—a.k.a. our mission field. We will likely not have this opportunity again next year, as the booth we are in has already been reserved by another. God provides us opportunities, but they are often brief and unique. We must take them when they appear as soon as they appear, for we cannot say when or if they will *reappear*.

As part of this tabling, we will be handing out bottles of water to those that pass by. In doing so, we answer the challenge given to us by Jesus Christ:

... I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me... Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see thee... thirsty and give thee drink?... And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me.' (Matthew 25:35-40)

And whoever gives to one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is a disciple, truly, I say to you, he shall not lose his reward." (Matthew 10:42)

Two-thousand water bottles have been ordered, Parish labels to go on them, as well as other promotional items. Please watch for our "Stickoree" when we will apply our labels to the bottles. A sign-up sheet will be at the Eidsvold Office during the week and will follow me to each worship service. I will remind those that sign up that the two congregations are not in competition with each other—we will give thanks if a single visitor attends either church. Speak positively about the other congregation and the ministries that they provide for everyone in the parish. If you do not know the answer to a question about Eidsvold or Svea, direct the questioner to a member of that congregation. Making individual connections is often key to community growth.

Below are 2 stories of how LWR kits are helping families and children.

1 Did you know LWR quilts also help children grow up to be strong and healthy?

Stunting is caused by chronic malnutrition in a child's early years. Children who are stunted are more likely to get sick, take longer to get better and they often experience developmental delays and have trouble learning. Stunting is more than just being short – it prevents a child from reaching their potential.

Researchers looked into the cause of stunting in Tanzania and discovered that children were not only hungry – they were cold. Instead of using every last calorie to grow, they were burning significant energy just to keep their bodies warm.

So thanks to all the quilters and the works of their hands – children in Tanzania have quilts to keep them warm and help them grow up strong and healthy!

2 In times of disaster, LWR quilts and kits are an answer to prayer

The violent earthquake that struck several times in February killed tens of thousands of our neighbors in Turkey.

Lutheran World Relief along with other partners immediately:

airlifted tents, tarps, winter clothing & solar lights

distributed ready to eat food and hot meals, sleeping bags and sleeping mats

delivered Lutheran World Relief quilts, Baby Care Kits, and Personal Care Kits to our neighbors during the hardest time of their lives, when they are exhausted, homeless, grieving, and terrified.

Today LWR and other partners are constructing a container city with 500 homes in one of the hardest hit communities. Each family's container will have 2 rooms – a bathroom with a flushing toilet, and a kitchen. The container city includes clean running water. Each container home has a private garden area to call their own.

Thank you for being an answer to prayer and being a loving neighbor as LWR continues the recovery in Turkey for years to come.
