Although it seems like we just got done with Christmas, Lent is already upon us. Ash Wednesday is February 14— service at 7 pm at Eidsvold. Lent has the stereotype of being the "sad" time in the Church year but it is really an *intentional* time where Christians around the globe slow-down, look past the world we have built, and on to the world God has built for us. It is our shared time of repentance and *re*focus on God—one where we take a spiritual journey with Jesus to His Cross and Empty Tomb. Our Lenten Services will focus on getting the most out of this journey as we look at Christian faith practices. My goal is to offer you a sampling of many different things we can do as Christians. Do not feel like you have to take on all or any of the opportunities offered up, they are just shown for your consideration.

The Journey of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, a moment when we acknowledge that our very separation from dust comes from the love of God, both in this life and the next, and Lent will end with our celebration of God's victory over Sin and Death on Easter Sunday. Over the forty days in between, many people give something up; a nasty habit or indulgence. I think of this like not snacking before going to a fine restaurant—it changes the way we experience the journey's end. Other people take on something new during Lent; a faith practice or Godly habit. They give it a shot for forty days and see if they find meaning enough to retain it in their lives.

An Eidsvold tradition includes locking away the "Alleluia" banner for Easter—Christians have kept themselves from saying that word during Lent for over 1700 years! It makes saying "Alleluia" at Easter all the more joyous. I would encourage all of you to challenge yourselves this Lent. Fall back on the strength that God offers you and take advantage of the opportunities provided by the Parish.

Parish Lenten Opportunities

o The Lenten suppers and Services–Locations will rotate each week. The meal starts at 6 and the service at 7, Wednesday nights.

o Parish Choir –On Wednesdays at 5 pm, a unified choir will meet to practice.

o Loop Groups – I was invited by the ELCA pastors in Red Wing to make a "Loop" video.

Loops are small groups that meet in homes, watch a video, and then discuss it. The videos

and discussion guides are already made, meaning that the Loop Groups can set their own schedule in meetings. The goal is to build small communities within the larger community.

o The Devotion Gospels – Members can purchase (\$2) a devotion journal for the Gospel of John. We as a congregation will prayerfully read through John during Lent.



Loop Groups

Pastor Al was invited to make Loop videos with the ELCA pastors in Red Wing. These six videos are ten-minute Lenten devotions covering Jesus' journey to the Cross. Loops are small groups that meet, watch the video, and then discuss it. Since life can be hectic, Loop Groups are encouraged to set their meeting schedule. These videos will premier through Lent but will stay posted on YouTube indefinitely, along with discussion guides, so folks can use them when they are able. If you're interested in Loops but feel like a lot is going on in your life this Lent, then wait until after Easter to meet. Loop Groups are just another opportunity for you. The goal is to build small communities within the larger community. Loops are intended to meet in homes but any place where people can connect is great. In Red Wing, Loops have met over Zoom, at a Care Center, the Library, restaurants, and at the churches. The plan moving forward is to release a new series each summer, fall, and Lent--if it doesn't work now, there will be other opportunities. If you would be interested in hosting or joining a Loop, please connect with Pastor Al or the Parish Office.

This Loop series is modified for Lent. Typically, Loop videos run about 15 minutes and include a musical offering, a perspective from a parishioner as well as from a pastor. Pastor Al assisted with another set this fall, which could be used in the future. Past Loop Videos can be found on United Lutheran of Red Wing's YouTube page.
