Greetings from the Parsonage,

I have had a song stuck in my head all week, a single lyric to be exact, it goes “Humble thyself in the sight of the Lord.” We will have to sing it some Sunday and get it stuck in everyone’s head! It is a needed message for us. It is easy to cast ourselves as perfect beings, without needs or weaknesses—we all do it. To “humble thyself” is to throw off the delusions that we feed ourselves and to return to what is true and right.

The word “humility” comes from the Latin term for “earth” or “ground.” The connection comes from the Creation narrative in Genesis. We read in the second chapter of that book that “the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.” In this sense, Christian humility is to recognize the reality of our existence, and our perpetual need for God. Without the Divine’s first gift of life, humanity would be but the dust of the earth. But we will explore that further in Lent—beginning with Ash Wednesday on February 18.

Lent is a time of reflection, of slowing down, and of remembering who sits with ultimate power and might—all branches of Christian humility. In the seasons of life, certain seasons of the Church will speak to us more than others. The voice of Lent rings loudest not only when we have been carried away by our Pride and Ego, but also in moments when we have taken on the weight of this world. This is the other side of humility—we are not called to crush but we are also not called to be crushed. It is not your job, nor mine, nor any of the beloved who sit in our pews to save the world—Lent is a time we remember whose job it is. In times of unrest, uncertainty, division, anger, what-have-you, it is tempting to turn to ourselves, but Lent is a practice in turning to God. And my genuine hope is that by the time you read this, there will be so much unity, peace, and fellowship in the news that you think, “What in the world is Pastor talking about!”

In the song, the lyric “Humble thyself in the sight of the Lord” is answered “... And He shall lift you up.” And God shall lift us up—both in this time and in the time to come. I pray that you remember that, and have the faith to be lifted by our Lord.

Let's spread some Easter Cheer!


