Began reading the Bible throng on 10-30-27. THE FIRST BOOK OF MOSES, COMMONLY CALLED GENESIS

Earlier this year I was looking through my Grandfathers Bible. I must've seen before what he had written at the beginning and the end of it but this time I realized what an accomplishment he had achieved. On October 30, 1927 he started reading the Bible and on December 5, 1927 he finished it. I did a little computation and it looks like he read the Bible in 37 days which, in his Bible, meant 32 1/2 pages per day while he was taking classes at Luther seminary. I know he didn't skip class because I have all his class notes from this time!

I have decided to follow in my Grandfathers footsteps. I challenge myself to read the entire Bible between October 30 and December 5. He read the American standard version which is a little rougher than the King James Version. I'm going to use a more contemporary Bible, a faithful translation of the original languages the Bible was written in, but easier to catch the meaning. It's called "The Message: The Bible in Contemporary Language" a popular translation by Eugene Peterson. He was a conservative in some ways and a very free spirit in others.

If you join me and take the "Pastor Kraabel's 37 day Challenge", I offer this suggestion: each day read from the Old Testament, the Psalms and the New Testament. Otherwise, it's more likely you'll bog down if you read it straight through.

Let me know if you accept the challenge. We can encourage each other to keep going!

PUBLIC HEALTH COVID TESTING UPDATE

Ellsworth COVID-19 Drive Up Community Testing Site at Pierce Pepin Cooperative Services is open Monday and Thursday mornings from 9 a.m.—11 a.m. (note change in times).

As cases of COVID-19 rise, the demand for WI National Guard community testing sites has been increasing. To accommodate additional testing locations, the Guard is adjusting times. "We are grateful to have the support of the Wisconsin National Guard to provide testing to our community. Many communities have recently requested this help, so we will need to be flexible in order to share this resource with other counties" said AZ Snyder, Pierce County Health Officer.

Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms or who has been in close contact with someone who tested positive for the virus is eligible for testing. Please note the following:

- All testing is drive-up without appointments. Pre-registration on the day of your test is recommended to speed up the testing process: https://register.covidconnect.wi.gov/
- PPCS is located at the corner or Hwy 10 and Hwy 63 in Ellsworth (enter the testing site on Hwy 63).
- The test is free and no insurance is needed.
- Parents/guardians must be present to consent for testing minors aged 1 to 17. Children under 12 months old are not eligible for testing at this site.

To get the most current information on testing, vaccinations, quarantine and isolation guidelines, and number of cases visit:

The covid 19 dashboard is updated on Mondays only. Scroll down to the CDC screen which is updated daily. Click on county view. Enter state and county. Scroll down a little and you will find the number of cases in the last 7 days as well as hospitalizations. You can use this CDC screen to check on cases in any state and county, to get state and national covid information, and graphs showing comparisons of number of cases a year ago and now.

Current Pierce County data is 154 cases in the last 7 days and 3 hospitalizations. Goodhue County is 115 cases and also 3 hospitalizations.

Continue to be vigilant about wearing masks to protect yourself, social distancing, washing hands and sanitizing common areas,
