

- 2. At July worship in our buildings, we will receive our offerings in a basket during worship. At Eidsvold, those who sign up for inside registration will also be the ushers for offering.
- 3. Public Health says we can sing at outdoor worship so we will sing at Worship in the Park on July 11th.
- 4. If the congregation is 70% vaccinated we can sing indoors. I don't know what our vaccinated percentage might be but I'm sure it's less than 70%. But occasionally we will sing one hymn in the building. **PLEASE do NOT sing with full gusto**—let's take this slow and easy as we don't want to be known as the congregation that sang hymns in the building and spread the virus.
- 5. We will continue to use the sign-in sheets throughout the summer, perhaps longer. If there is a covid situation, we will know who was at worship and will be able to contact you.
