#### Malawi Update—July 2021

Warm greetings on behalf of our friends and partners in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Malawi. (ELCM)

After two waves of the Coronavirus, Malawi is now in it's third pandemic wave. The Delta Variant has proven to be much more contagious and much more deadly than the first two. Daily cases continue to rise rapidly, deaths from Covid are substantially higher, and the government has issued another order for masks, distancing, and minimal group activity. Only 1.5% of the population are fully vaccinated.



#### Ordination of the First Woman Pastor

The ELCM also has plans to celebrate the ordination of the first woman pastor in Malawi, Bertha Monkhondya. She finished her studies on August 2nd and will be ordained on September 12, and is I ooking forward to her first call as a pastor in Evangelical Lutheran Church Malawi!

#### **Mission Support**

As partners in the gospel, we continue to walk with our siblings in Malawi, and invite you to hold them in prayer as they face the ongoing difficulties of this pandemic.

Many throughout our synod have reached out wondering how to help in light of the extreme struggles that our friends are facing, so we have prepared an appeal and invite you to prayerfully consider a financial gift for the ELCM.
