Greetings from the Parsonage!

A place name tells you as more about the namer as it does the named. Place names reveal where people have come from, where they hope to go, or even how they want the world to understand them. The names of our two congregations are especially interesting for they have nothing to do with Scripture or our great story of faith! Eidsvold is a town in Norway-the birthplace of some of our founders. Svea is the personification of Sweden-the Swedish equivalent of Lady Liberty is Mother Svea. It was common for Scandinavians to reference towns or cultural markers when naming their parishes. These "ethnic" names sent a message to other immigrants that here was a place where they'd feel at home, here was a place that would provide the comfort and support of the old country. These names helped connect a specific community with a congregation that vowed to serve them. I like our two names. They remind us that our forebears left behind everything they had for the sake of a new beginning. Was it easy? No. Was there sacrifice? Yes. Am I glad to inherit their work? Yes. Throughout the Gospel, Jesus asks us to leave the world behind, to leave our lives behind, for the sake of living in Him and coming into His Kingdom. Jesus offers us a New Beginning in Him at the expense of everything else. Our two names remind us that we are not the first to face challenges and sacrifice but are rather a part of a community defined by such a leap of faith. A foreign name also reminds us that God is the constant through all change. Although we no longer worship in Swedish or Norwegian, we continue to worship the same Risen Lord.

So how about today? How does a visitor understand our name? They won't likely hear it and think of their home in Scandinavia like visitors once did—but maybe that's a good thing. Because most people don't know what an "Eidsvold" or "Svea" is, we get to define it for them. By our actions and work in this world, the names that were once synonymous with the old kingdom can be synonymous with God's New Kingdom. Scripture is full of place names defined by God's Work there, not their namers' intent.

How do you want your congregation to be defined in this community? Like our forebears, how do we send the message that our congregation continues to be a place of comfort and support in an often unsettling land? That we are a home for all who make their journey through life? Food for thought.




