Warm Greetings from the Parsonage!

I am proud to report that our fair booth was a complete success! Members of the Parish gave away over 2000 bottles of water and one lovely green quilt! I thank everyone who volunteered their time to connect with fairgoers as well as those who donated cases of water. Living your Gospel call can come in many forms, but service is never a terrible one. If you ever have an idea for the Parish to serve or engage with the community in any way, let it be known.

On September 24, the Parish will be welcoming Pastor Al Erickson from Adults Saving Kids. During both services, Pastor Erickson will be teaching on the Church's response to human trafficking. The service will remain the same length at both churches. According to their website, "The work of Adult Saving Kids is to prevent harm being done to young people by preparing their parents and grandparents to equip them with faith stories, support their identity in Christ through baptism and share with wise skills by which they can avoid the traps set for them."

Human trafficking is not a foreign issue, it is not an evil known only by distant lands, but rather tragically occurs in the shadows of our very own home. Instead of choosing not to see it, we should prepare ourselves for its evils. Many, myself included, look upon this cultural plague and wonder, "What can I do about it?", "Can a single person do anything about it?" With this in mind, Pastor Erickson has developed a faith-based program for guardians to use at home. He has worked with several former traffickers as well as countless survivors and their families to develop the material. Pastor Erickson and Adults Saving Kids has been featured in The Lutheran, The Christian Science Monitor, as well as on the Oprah Winfrey Show and ABC/20-20. Given Pastor Erickson's extremely busy schedule, this program is certainly a blessing for our parish. All people with children in their lives are encouraged to attend. # Eidsvold-Svea First Joint Council Meeting August 2, 2023 6:30 – 8:00 pm

<u>Attendees:</u> Wade Strain – Svea President, Dennis Rieck – Svea Vice President, Kelly Knutson, Yvonne Manore–Secretary, Lynda Phillips, Mary Schaver – Svea Treasurer, Tracie Esterby – Eidsvold Secretary, Anne Girdeen – Eidsvold Treasurer, Amanda Jepson – Eidsvold Vice President

#### 1) Joint council meetings

- The members agreed that joint council meetings should follow individual council meetings by one week every quarter. Proposed was August, November, February and May, 3<sup>rd</sup> week joint meeting (assuming 2<sup>nd</sup> week is individual council meeting).
- The next meeting will be dependent on when the signing of the pastoral contract occurs; the next meeting may need to move up to October so the joint council can get some alignment with the new pastor should one be hired by then.
- There was discussion around when the service year starts and ends for each congregation. At Svea it is November and January for Eidsvold. There was discussion around whether to align on this start date, but it was decided that it was not a huge deviation and we would not change for either church until we get some run time.
- It was decided that we would determine joint council office positions at the next meeting after a pastor has accepted the position and when we had all council members present (Jason Helseth, Eidsvold Council President was out of town).

#### 2) Call process status and next steps

- The Call Committee has selected a pastoral candidate they would like to make an offer to.
- Anne Girdeen and Tracie Esterby passed out the financial package for review and discussion.
- Wade made a motion to approve the financial package and Dennis seconded the motion.
- Tracie will notify the call committee that they can proceed with the offer.
- potential vote on September 10<sup>th</sup> for Rally Sunday (first day of Sunday school)
- members at Eidsvold must receive letter in the mail notifying them of upcoming vote 2 weeks prior to voting day

#### 3) Booth support at Pierce County Fair

- Dennis plans to bring 2,000 bottles of water on Wednesday. Kelly was going to test the labels to see if they would fall off with condensation.
- Tracie was going to call confirmation students to remind them that they could get school volunteer hours for supporting. She would pair students up with an adult. (two hour shifts)
- t-shirts will be available for handout
- water will be handed out free of charge
- recommendation given to post pictures or have a laptop up cycling through photos from our churches (may be done next year since short notice)

#### **Continued Joint Council Minutes:**

#### 4) Youth events and frequency

- Youth events occur 4 times a year at Eidsvold
  - Examples:
    - Fall: October Reformation Sunday (breakfast followed by cleanup at the cemetery)
    - Winter: bowling?
    - Spring: Feed My Starving Children?
    - Summer: Vacation Bible School

#### 5) Confirmation status and format discussion

- Tracie Esterby discussed the confirmation format for Eidsvold and how it has been implemented the past several years with Pastor Mike. She also cited some examples of how previous pastors have implemented it.
  - most recently, confirmation is for  $6^{th} 9^{th}$  grade
  - 5 weeks with homework, confirmed in May
  - take sermon notes
  - adult members attend with confirmands
- Svea has 2 confirmation students; Eidsvold has 15

#### 6) New members service for October

- 3 Cs need to be met to be a new member: Commune, Contribute, Confirmed
- (did not discuss date)

#### 7) Directory recognition

- Discussed collecting pictures for directory (Dennis and Mary)
- Pastor and Melody (music leader) in front of directory
- meeting with photographer on August 17<sup>th</sup> so pictures need to be collected by then

#### 8) Fees for church rental – member vs. non-member

- Svea currently charges \$75 for non-members; members donate
- Eidsvold is charging \$100 fee for non-members with a \$100 deposit which will be returned following event assuming church is left as clean as it was when event began; members donate
- Svea will evaluate their fees

#### 9) Special upcoming services for the fall

- Rally Sunday is September 10<sup>th</sup>: backpacks, Sunday school start
  - potentially vote on calling of a pastor at both congregations
- Bethlehem closing on September 17<sup>th</sup> at 2pm
  - still having normal morning services with Eidsvold at 8:45a.m and Svea 10:30 a.m.
- Reformation Sunday, October 29<sup>th</sup> joint service
  - members agreed 10 am service with egg bake breakfast afterward
- Sunday school church program (Christmas Program)
  - Megan Franklin from Eidsvold will determine practice schedule and program date
- Christmas Services
  - to be aligned with new pastor

#### 10) Validate phone directory is ready for print

- Svea Council members validating a few member numbers but overall ready to print

#### 11) Discussion on newsletter – any changes?

- Tracie will be printing the next newsletter August 24<sup>th</sup> and handing out at worship in the park
- August 26<sup>th</sup> in the Red Wing Band Shell: Elvis impersonator

#### God's Work our Hands – September 10th after Eidsvold Worship



Cleanliness may not actually be next to godliness, but it certainly helps a person feel more human. When families find their homes destroyed, or must flee for their safety, soap and a towel rarely make the cut for what they can carry. Arriving in a refugee camp or other place of safety, they are scared, vulnerable and dirty from the travel. The simple items included in a Personal Care Kit provide much-needed self care, critical germ fighting supplies and the chance for our neighbors in need to regain dignity amidst fear and uncertainty.

On Sunday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, after worship, we will assemble approximately 30 health kits at Eidsvold. This could be completed in 15-20 minutes or less if several come to the basement to help. Students can place the items in the towel, but adults are needed to wrap the string around and tie in knots to secure.

Phyllis Beastrom is one of eight voting members from the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin to the Women of the ELCA Convention <u>September 18-21</u> which is being held in Phoenix. At the convention we will act on resolutions and memorials, constitutional changes, and elect officers for the next three years. We held a zoom convention three years ago to conduct the business of the organization.

September 21-24 will be the Women of the ELCA Gathering, being held at the Phoenix convention center, focusing on the theme **JUST LOVE**. There will be many worship opportunities, speakers, workshops, and in
